Empower Students Through Scholarships

Award 25 scholarships annually to graduating seniors to help them achieve their post-secondary education and career aspirations.

Feed Hungry Students

Fund food pantries in every school to ensure no child goes hungry.

Award grants to teachers for innovative projects that enrich learning experiences and create opportunities for student success.
